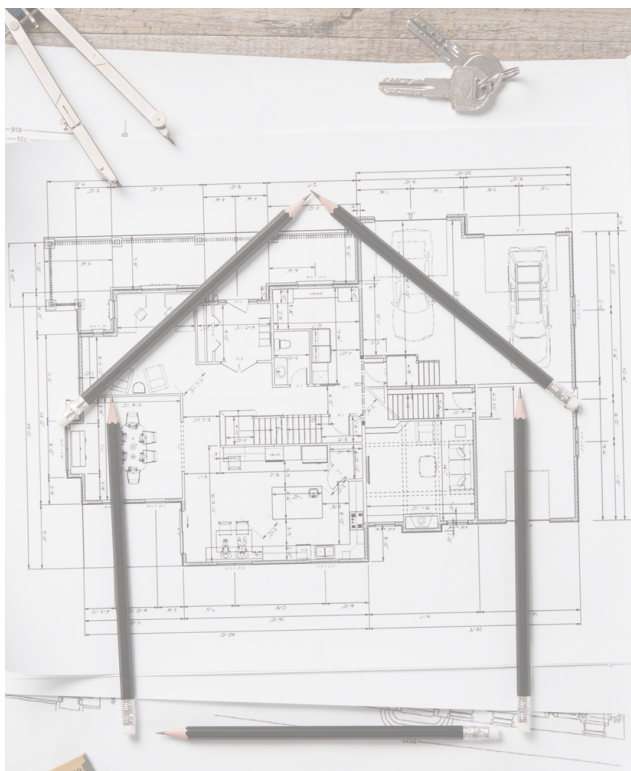

Opportunity Street will offer you the chance to become part of a dynamic community of choir conductors who support each other on the journey towards personal and professional growth.

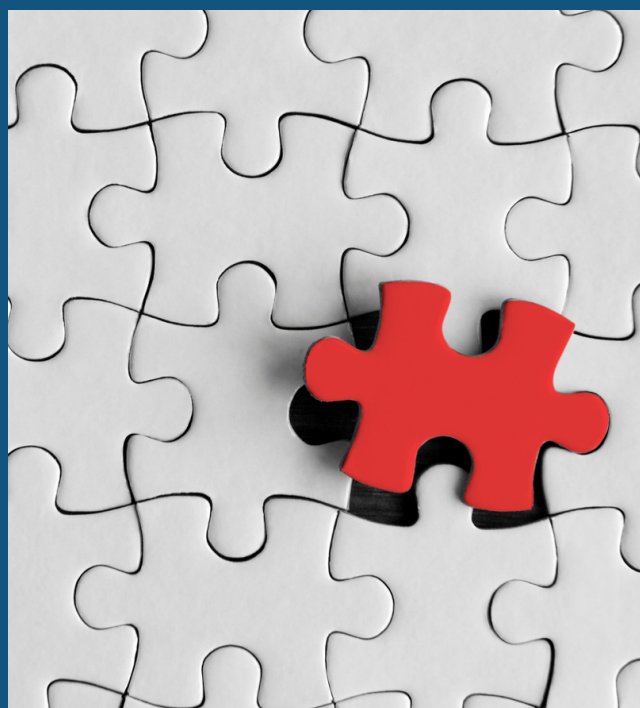
