Instructions for Sending Money via PayPal:

1. Sign up for free on the PayPal website (www.paypal.com) If you already have an account, simply log in with your credentials.
2. On the PayPal homepage, look for the option "Send Money" or "Transfer Money". Click it to go to the "Send Money" page.
3. On the "Send Money" page, there's a field where you need to enter the recipient's email address. Please enter the recipient's PayPal email address that they have provided to you.
4. Enter the amount you want to send. Make sure you select the correct currency.
5. Carefully check all the details to ensure everything is correct. If all is correct, click "Continue" or "Send Payment" to complete the transaction.
6. After you have sent the payment, you will receive a confirmation email from PayPal.

Please note that PayPal may charge fees for the transaction. Therefore, check the fees that may apply to your transaction before making the payment. PayPal also accepts credit cards as a payment method. Users can link their credit card to their PayPal account and then pay either through their PayPal balance or their credit card. If a user makes a payment via PayPal and their PayPal account does not have sufficient funds to cover the payment, PayPal will charge the required amounts to the linked credit card.

Transferring Money with Wise: Quick Guide

1. Register and Verify on <https://wise.com> Sign up with your email and set a password. Verify your identity to enable transfers.
2. Start a Transfer: From the home screen, choose 'Transfer'.
3. Source and Amount: Select whether the funds come from an external account or a Wise balance. Enter how much you want to send, or the recipient should receive, including the currency.
4. Recipient Details: Add your recipient by their name, Wise tag, email, or phone number. If new, click 'Add recipient' and provide their bank details or email.
5. Finalize and Deposit: Review the transfer details and choose your deposit method. Confirm to initiate the transfer.
6. Notification: We'll inform both you and your recipient via email or app once the transfer begins and when the money has arrived.
